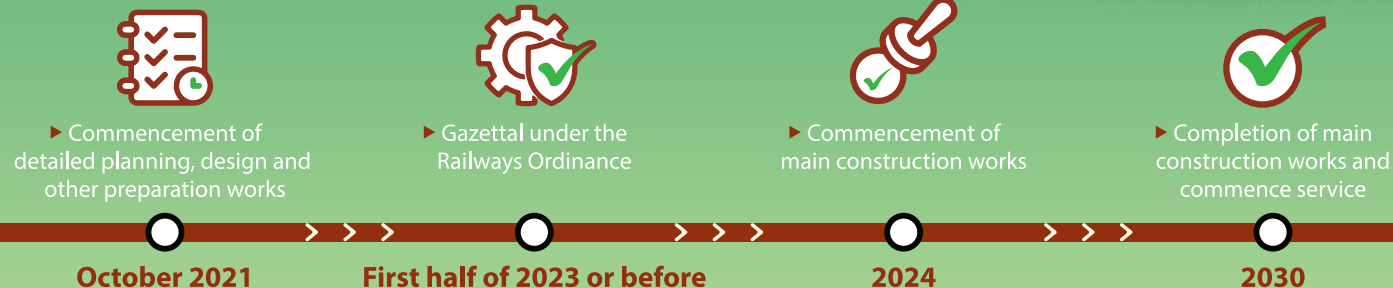
About Hung Shui Kiu Station on Tuen Ma Line

Hung Shui Kiu Station is to be constructed between Tin Shui Wai Station and Siu Hong Station and located at the future Hung Shui Kiu/Ha Tsuen New Development Area. The station not only provides more convenient and environmentally friendly train services, but also strengthens the connection with the districts nearby and boosts the economic development in the region.

Station Name

- ▶ "Hung Shui Kiu Station" is in fact a project name. The formal name of the station will be confirmed at a time closer to service commencement.
- ▶ Several factors will be taken into consideration for naming a station, such as the representativeness, geographic location and local characteristics, etc.

Project Timeline



Remark: Hung Shui Kiu Station will be built on the existing Tuen Ma Line (the former West Rail Line). The Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report for the West Rail Line project was completed in accordance to the relevant statutory procedures. The project team will apply the Variation of Environmental Permit as per relevant statutory procedures as needed, ensuring the construction and operation of the Hung Shui Kiu Station comply with applicable statutory requirements.
